

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of FY 1998 Community Based Diabetes Prevention Program
Budget Modification #1)**

RESOLUTION NO. 98-269

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Department of Health and Human Services submitted and was approved to establish the Community Based Diabetes Prevention Program under the special Diabetes Program for Indians, authorized by the Balanced Budget Act; and

WHEREAS, Legislative Council, through Resolution No. 98-149, approved a five (5) year project and one (1) year budget of \$536,942.00; and

WHEREAS, a budget modification is submitted for review and approval by the Department of Health and Human Services, to decrease the original amount by \$376.00 and eliminated line items pertaining to vehicles.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,

- 1. That the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves the attached budget in the amount of \$536,566.**
- 2. The Tohono O'odham Nation Officials, to wit: the Chairman and Vice Chairman and any designated Official are hereby authorized to negotiate, execute the contract and expend funds when received.**

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 06TH, day of JULY, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,927.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 203.0 [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
