RESOLUTION NO. 98-271

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating FY 1997 Grant with five (5) year plan, and the Title IV-B Subpart I of the Social Security Act - five (5) year plan; and

WHEREAS, any modifications affecting the funding and funding levels of the grant shall be submitted for review and approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council; and

WHEREAS, the Title IV-B Subpart I of the Social Security Act has decreased the allocation from \$52,000 to \$46,047 for the FY 1998 budget; and

WHEREAS, an attached modification has been submitted for review and approval by the Tohono O'odham Department of Human Services - Division of Child Welfare Services/Family Preservation Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that:

1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes expenditures of these funds according to the attached budget for the following program.

A. Family Preservation and Support Services

2. That the Tohono O'odham Nation, to wit, the Chairman and any designated Official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant.
