

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Acceptance of Budget Modifications for the 1994 HUD-HOME Grant -
Administration, Baboquivari, Chukut Kuk, Gu Achi, Hickiwan, Pisinemo,
San Xavier, Schuk Toak, and Sif Oidak)**

RESOLUTION NO. 98-275

WHEREAS, in 1994 the Tohono O'odham Nation applied and received a HOME grant which would provide substantial and moderate renovation of homes for low income families in the following communities: Baboquivari, Chukut Kuk, Gu Achi, Hickiwan, Pisinemo, San Xavier, Schuk Toak, and Sif Oidak; and

WHEREAS, this grant has not been implemented as scheduled due to shortfall by the previous Administration; and

WHEREAS, delayed implementation has required the new administration to reassess the budget; and

WHEREAS, reassessment requires budget modification for the 94 HOME grant; and

WHEREAS, the budgets will be restored to the original amounts reflecting in the HUD Cost Summary dated July 15, 1994; and

WHEREAS, the required budget modifications are as follows:

Administration budget: The increase in Salaries is to comply with Executive Branch Wage/Scale & Compensation Salary adopted by the Tohono O'odham Tribal Council, Resolution No. 97-179. Salaries will include retroactive pay beginning January 1998. Fringe Benefits are increased to meet the 32% rate. The Contingency line item is increased to meet the unforeseen situations during the life time of the grant. Professional Services are increased to meet the expenses for the assistance of expertise. The addition of Utilities is to pay for new

3 **and continued services during the life of the grant. The addition of**
4 **Capital Equipment is to provide vehicle transportation for**
5 **Administration. The decrease in Training Registration, Travel**
6 **Expenses, Mileage Allowance, Dues & Subscriptions, Lease & Rentals,**
7 **and Office & Communication Equipment was due to cost over**
8 **estimated for a year time frame.**

9
10 **District Budgets: Due to the need to expedite the 94 HOME Grant in a**
11 **one year time frame we will revert back to the third party**
12 **contractor(s). Elimination of all line items expect for Construction -**
13 **IHS and Contingency in all district budgets. The additional line item**
14 **for Professional Services will be added to all district budgets for the**
15 **third party contractor(s).**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council**
17 **hereby approves of the proposed budget modifications to the 1994**
18 **HUD HOME Grant and authorizes expenditures in accordance with the**
19 **attached budget modifications.**

21 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the**
22 **Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials to wit: the Chairman, Vice**
23 **Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized to**
24 **negotiate and execute the grant and expend funds.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 06th,**
26 **day of JULY, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,326.5**
27 **FOR; 600.5 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested**
28 **in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham**
 Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by
 the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,
 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
