Safe Ride Services, Inc. continues to provide non-emergency 13 medically necessary transportation services within the Nation 14 without proper authorization from the Nation; and 15 WHEREAS, Safe Ride Services, Inc. has proposed a collaborative agreement to 16 the Commerce and Health and Human Services Committees: and 17 WHEREAS, the Commerce and Health and Human Services Committees have 18 19 reviewed and considered the collaborative agreement; and 20 WHEREAS, the Commerce and Health and Human Services Committees desire 21 that O'odham have non-emergency medically necessary 22 transportation services and that the interests of Safe Ride Services, 23 Inc.'s employees be protected and promoted; and 24 the Commerce and Health and Human Services Committees WHEREAS, 25 recommend that the Nation not enter into the collaborative 26 agreement proposed by Safe Ride Services, Inc. 27 28

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. The Nation declines to enter into the collaborative agreement which Safe Ride Services, Inc. proposed.
- 2. Safe Ride Services, Inc. is authorized and granted nonexclusive permission to provide medically necessary transportation services within the Nation retroactive to the date of expiration of Resolution No. 98-142 and for one year from the date of enactment of this resolution.
- 3. Permission is conditioned upon Safe Ride Services, Inc.'s compliance with all laws of the Nation as well as applicable federal and state laws, and full cooperation with the Nation and the Indian Health Service.
- 4. Within thirty days of the enactment of this resolution the Tribal **Employment Rights Office and Safe Ride Services, Inc. shall** have developed a Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") to be submitted for the Legislative Council's approval.
- 5. The Legislative Council reserves the right to rescind this resolution within 30 days.
- 6. The Health and Human Services Department and the Health and Human Services Committee are authorized to review other transportation proposals and present these proposals to the Council no later than September 30, 1998.
