
RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Supporting H.R. 4119 - "Tohono O'odham Religious Area Restoration Act of 1998")

4	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation over the past fifteen years requested the
5		return of the Baboquivari Peak and Mountain recognizing the sacred
6		symbol of its people, and as the center of Mother Earth and the
7		dwelling place of l'itoi, our Creator; and
8	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council enacted Resolution No. 98-
9		079, respectfully requesting the United States Congress to return 2,065
10		acres of BLM land which consists of the eastern portion of the
11		Baboquivari Peak to the Tohono O'odham Nation within the 105 th
12		Congress; and
13	WITEDEAS	the Tohono O'odham Nation held public meetings to hear the
14	WHEREAS,	me tonono o ounam Nation nelu public meetings to near me
15		concerns of individuals and other organizations on the proposed
16		transfer of land; and
17	WHEREAS,	on June 23, 1998, the Honorable Ed Pastor of the 2 nd Congressional
18		District of the State of Arizona, United States House of Representatives,
19		on behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation introduced H.R. 4119 cited as
20		the "Tohono O'odham Religious Area Restoration Act of 1998."
21	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
22		hereby supports the enactment of H.R. 4119, "Tohono O'odham
23		Religious Restoration Act of 1998" in returning to the Tohono O'odham
24		Nation, 2065 acres of land consisting of the eastern portion of the

26		Baboquivari Peak.
27	BE IT FUR	THER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation is thankful of the
28		efforts of the Honorable Congressman Ed Pastor in introducing the

4 8	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation prays to I'itoi, our						
0 9	Creator, that all our efforts are with our Creator's guidance and						
10	wisdom.						
11	The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the <u>08TH</u>						
12	day of <u>JULY, 1998</u> at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of <u>1,927.0</u> FOR; <u>-0-</u> AGAINST; <u>-0-</u> NOT VOTING; and <u>[05]</u> ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested						
13	in the Council by Section <u>1(j)</u> of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved						
14	by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
