4 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation with a land base of 2.8 million acres and**
5 **a population of 23,000 members manages its own Law Enforcement,**
6 **Detention and Ranger program; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Police Department, through program review has**
8 **identified operational needs which are not met by the current budget;**
9 **and**

10 **WHEREAS, through budget review, the Tohono O'odham Police Department has**
11 **identified funds available within the Tribal Budget for modification;**
12 **and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department requests**
14 **authorization to modify the use of said funds where the total dollar**
15 **amount of the budget is unchanged; and**

16 **WHEREAS, by this resolution the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorized**
17 **said changes and also authorizes the employee positions contained in**
18 **this modification to be a recurring portion of the Police Department's**
19 **Tribal Base Budget. The Tohono O'odham Police Department**
20 **acknowledges its responsibility to factor these new positions into the**
21 **FY 99 budget without increasing the total dollar amount of the**
22 **recurring Tribal Base Budget.**

23 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council of the Tohono**
24 **O'odham Nation authorizes the proposed budget modification and**
25 **the addition of the proposed recurring new positions.**
