reserved federal funding, and authorization of expenditure in  
accordance with attached budget)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 98-291**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation utilizes pesticides at the tribal farms and hires commercial applicators to apply pesticides within the tribal buildings, community homes, schools, and business establishments; and**

**WHEREAS, potential safety and environmental issues may exist due to the pesticides applications; and**

**WHEREAS, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Region IX has announced there is reserved funding available to implement a Pesticide Regulatory Program for the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has prepared a grant application to EPA, Region IX Cross Media Division for the Cooperative Agreement Funds to implement a Pesticide Regulatory Program; and**

**WHEREAS, the Cooperative Agreement Funds will allow the Nation to develop an overall pesticide use assessment, create a tribal pesticide ordinance to regulate pesticide use, sale and distribution and provide educational outreach to community members, farm employees, schools, tribal officials and business entities; and**

**WHEREAS, the establishment of a Pesticide Regulatory Program will allow the Nation to address any pesticide related concerns and develop future enforcement capabilities to assist in the preservation of the environment for the well being of the Nation's members.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council (Council) hereby approves the Tohono O'odham Nation Cooperative**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council accepts the grant funding that EPA has reserved for the Tohono O'odham Nation.**

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Council approves the attached budget and authorizes the expenditure of Pesticide funds according to this budget.**

**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 13TH day of JULY, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,620.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 307.0 [08] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
