12	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation will greatly
13	benefit from these individuals when they are trained and ar
14	employable.
15	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the
16	Tohono O'odham Nation Officials, to wit: the Chairman and an
17	designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute th
18	· ·
19	contract, provided however, that any amendment affecting the funding
20	or funding levels of this contract shall be submitted for further prio
21	approval by this Council.

25	O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and
26	approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) of March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
