

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(In support of the Johnson O'Malley Educational Services -
FY 98 Modification #2)**

RESOLUTION NO. 98-311

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'ohdam Nation has successfully operated the Johnson O'Malley program for numerous years; and

WHEREAS, the Johnson O'Malley Program supplements the Gila Bend Unified School District #24, Indian Oasis Baboquivari Unified School District #40 as well as the Tohono O'ohdam Early Childhood Head Start Program; and

WHEREAS, examples of how the Johnson O'Malley Program assists the above mentioned entities include: purchase of classroom supplies, payment of dues and subscriptions for educational books, magazines, etc., and covering costs for consultant services e.g. for Annual Indian Day activities and also covering costs for special activities i.e. field trips, educational camps, purchase of plaques, trophies, etc; and

WHEREAS, under the B.I.A. master contract for all 638 federal programs reflects an increase for the Johnson O'Malley program in the amount of \$7,895.00 for FY 1998; and

WHEREAS, in a memorandum of May 21, 1998 the Executive office gave program directive to prepare budget modification reflecting increases or decreases to existing FY 98 budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council supports the Johnson O'Malley Budget Modification #2 reflecting an increase of \$7,895.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the total Johnson O'Malley program budget of \$138,100.00 increased to \$145,995.00 for FY 1998.
