**RESOLUTION NO. 98-314**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Youth Services has brought forth its 1998-99 United Way Service Allocation Funding Proposal; and**

**WHEREAS, the United Way Executive staff and Board decided to escrow these funds beginning July 01, 1997 and requested United Way staff to find another way, other than the Fund Distribution Division RFP process, to channel United Way service allocation funds to the T.O.Y.S. program; and**

**WHEREAS, the \$8,400.00 reflects the actual amount of Service Allocation Funds in escrow for Tohono O'odham Youth Services; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Youth Services, Pro-Neighborhoods, and United Way through numerous meetings and discussions have decided to channel Service Allocation funds through Pro-Neighborhoods office; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Youth Services program through memorandum of understanding will now be working directly with Pro-Neighborhoods of Tucson to obtain service allocation funds; and**

**WHEREAS, the budget proposal is in accordance with Resolution No. 97-139 authorizing the Tohono O'odham Youth Services to enter into an agreement with United Way of Tucson.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves and supports the FY 1998-99 Tohono O'odham Youth Services United Way Budget.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves and supports the Tohono O'odham Youth Services to enter into an agreement with Pro-Neighborhoods of Tucson.**
