**WHEREAS, the \$7,303.00 reflects the actual amount of Donor Designation Funds
received by the Tohono O'odham Youth Services from United Way; and**


**WHEREAS, the funding amount are designated funds and may be used at the
Nation's discretion; and**

**WHEREAS, the budget proposal is in accordance with Resolution No. 97-139
authorizing the Tohono O'odham Youth Services to enter into an
agreement with United Way of Tucson.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
approves and supports the FY 1998-99 Tohono O'odham Youth Services
United Way Budget.**

O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and
approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on
March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
