**RESOLUTION NO. 98-320**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation prepared a grant proposal to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) for Brownfields Initiative Redevelopment funding to assess the Minerec Mining Chemical Company, located in San Xavier District; and**

**WHEREAS, the USEPA has granted the Tohono O'odham Nation the federal funding amount of \$200,000; and**

**WHEREAS, the funding will be utilized for assessment of sites that meet the requirements of future Brownfields Redevelopment such as the Minerec Mining Chemical Company; and**

**WHEREAS, the Brownfields Initiative Redevelopment Project will assist the Nation in their efforts to protect and maintain the environment for the well being of the Nation's members.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council (Council) hereby approves the Tohono O'odham Nation Brownfields Initiative Redevelopment Project.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council accepts the grant funding that EPA has reserved for the Tohono O'odham Nation.**

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Council approves the attached budget and authorizes the expenditure of the Brownfields Initiative Redevelopment funds according to this budget.**
