

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Acceptance of the Local Law Enforcement Block Grant Program Funds in  
the Amount of \$15,735.00 and Authorizing Expenditures of Funds)**

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**RESOLUTION NO. 98-327**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation") received notice of federal funds through the Department of Justice, Local Law Enforcement Block Grant Program ("LLEBG"); and**

**WHEREAS, the LLEBG office has awarded \$15,735.00 to the Tohono O'odham Police Department for the purposes of reducing crime and improving public safety; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Police Department has determined to use these funds for the purchase of law enforcement equipment in accordance with the scope of work and budget attached hereto; and**

**WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has reviewed the scope of work and the attached budget and recommends approval of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council accepts the Local Law Enforcement Block Grant Award in the amount of \$15,735 and authorizes the expenditure of funds in accordance with the attached budget as presented by the Tohono O'odham Police Department.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation be authorized to sign the agreement and to sign any other documents needed to implement this grant.**

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the expenditure of funds will end on September 30, 1998.**

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The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 06TH day of AUGUST, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,428.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 499.0 [08] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
