

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Appropriating from Savings \$1,404,995.36 for the Establishment of the
Tohono O'odham Community College)**

RESOLUTION NO. 98-328

**WHEREAS, Resolution 98-06 approved Ordinance 98-01 enacting the Charter of the
Tohono O'odham Community College (hereinafter "TOCC"); and**

**WHEREAS, a one-year budget of \$1,404,995.36 was identified as necessary for the
establishment of the TOCC; and**

**WHEREAS, the Charter of the TOCC, under Article 4, sets forth a fiduciary duty for
the TOCC Board by requiring that "the affairs of the TOCC shall be
managed by the Board of Trustees" and, under Article 7, that the Board
"may establish and maintain such bank accounts as may be necessary
and convenient" within the limitations provided in the Charter of the
TOCC.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
fully supports and appropriates \$1,404,995.36 from the Desert
Diamond savings, to be set aside in an interest bearing account to be
maintained by the TOCC Board for those purposes of establishing and
operating the TOCC.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the TOCC Board of Trustees is hereby authorized
to utilize any and all funds provided by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
Council in furtherance of the Charter.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the TOCC Board of Trustees has authority within the
parameters of the TOCC Charter to identify, receive and expend any and
all funds in furtherance of the Charter, including but not limited to any
funds available pursuant to P.L. 93-638, revenues of the Tohono
O'odham Nation and any other funds from any source previously
identified.**

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BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that this appropriation and the use of such funds by the TOCC Board is subject to the requirements set forth under the Charter of the TOCC as enacted by Ordinance 98-01 and any applicable laws of the Tohono O'odham Nation or United States.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 06TH day of AUGUST, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1.618.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 309.0[07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
