1 2 3 **RESOLUTION NO. 98-342** 4 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation"), in exercise of its sovereign 5 authority, desires to manage and regulate the storage, collection, 6 recycling, transportation and disposal of solid waste and certain 7 hazardous waste on lands within the boundaries of the Nation in order 8 to protect the Nation's environment, its natural resources, the political 9 integrity and economic security of the Nation, and the health, safety 10 and welfare of its members and all persons present on the lands of the 11 Nation: and 12 the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council ("Legislative Council") WHEREAS, 13 adopted the Solid Waste Management Code and Solid Waste 14 Management Plan on February 12, 1997 and amended the Solid Waste 15 Management Code on October 16, 1997; and 16 the adopted Solid Waste Management Plan is significantly 17 WHEREAS. 18 implemented and is now providing solid waste collection to almost all 19 villages by way of bins placed in each community and trucks that 20 collect the solid waste from the bins, and haul the waste to landfills 21 located off of the Nation's land; and 22 WHEREAS. the Nation has paid for 100% of the capital costs and approximately 50% **23** of the operating costs, and residents, businesses and agencies will pay 24 for approximately 50% of the operating costs; and 25 WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Management Program has placed bins for almost all 26 residents and businesses as of May 1998 with the placement of 480 solid 27 waste bins, and the collection of solid waste on a weekly basis; and 28

RESOLUTION NO. 98-342 (Create three new positions, purchase two new solid waste trucks and re-classify diesel mechanic position for the Tohono O'odham Solid Waste Management 1 Program) Page 2 of 4 2 WHEREAS, additional bins are being purchased and placed in locations that 3 district and village representatives have requested them be placed; and 4 WHEREAS. the Solid Waste Management Program has three solid waste drivers to 5 pick-up all trash including household, bulky waste, scrap metal, tires 6 7 and household hazardous waste and to clean up around bins that get 8 messy; and 9 WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Management Program has one secretary to answer 10 phones, process all paperwork for the program and also to collect, 11 tabulate and balance the payments from approximately 2000 solid 12 waste accounts on a monthly basis; and 13 the Solid Waste Management Program is finding that all the work it has WHEREAS. 14 been assigned can not get completed and is receiving numerous 15 complaints. 16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council 17 hereby approves the purchase of two additional vehicles, re-18 classification of the diesel mechanic position, creation of three new 19 positions - that of administrative assistant, solid waste driver and solid 20 waste laborer to assist the program in completing its mission. 21 22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the three new positions and the re-classification 23 will become part of the Solid Waste Management Program's base 24 budget for FY-99. 25 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the <u>01ST</u> day of <u>SEPTEMBER 1998</u> at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 26 1.927.0 FOR: -0- AGAINST: -0- NOT VOTING: and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono 27 O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on 28 March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
