

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Supporting Sif Oidak District's request to temporarily waive Ordinance  
05-82 from September 20, 1998 through October 05, 1998 for the  
St. Francis Feast Celebration in Anegam Village)**

**DEFEATED  
RESOLUTION NO. 98-349**

**WHEREAS, on April 06, 1982 the Papago Tribal Council now the Tohono O'odham  
Legislative Council enacted Ordinance 05-82 cited as the "Alcohol  
Beverage Licensing and Control Ordinance"; and**

**WHEREAS, the purpose of the Ordinance is to alternatively prohibit or sanction and  
license the introduction, sale, possession and consumption of alcohol  
beverages within the exterior boundaries of the Tohono O'odham Nation  
(formerly Papago Reservation, Arizona); and**

**WHEREAS, Section 4 (Four) titled, "District Option", empowered the eleven (11)  
Districts of the Tohono O'odham Nation to sanction the introduction, sale,  
possession and consumption of spiritous liquor within the exterior  
boundaries of the district in conformity with this ordinance; and**

**WHEREAS, a referendum vote of the registered voters of the Sif Oidak District made  
it lawful and legal to the sale, possession and consumption of alcohol  
beverages within the boundaries of the said district; and**

**WHEREAS, the St. Francis Feast Committee requested assistance from the Tohono  
O'odham Police Department to set up road blocks during this time for  
enforcement purposes; and**

**WHEREAS, the Sif Oidak District Council in consideration of the safety and welfare  
of all members of the Tohono O'odham Nation participating in the  
celebration respectfully request support of the Tohono O'odham  
Legislative Council to waive Ordinance 05-82 from September 20, 1998 to  
October 05, 1998.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council  
hereby supports the request from the Sif Oidak District Council to waive**

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
**Ordinance 05-82 effective throughout the Sif Oidak District to allow the Tohono O'odham Police Department to enforce all laws and ordinances for the protection and safety of all members of the Tohono O'odham Nation during the St. Francis Feast to be held in Anegam Village.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this waiver be from September 20, 1998 through October 05, 1998 to be effective only in Sif Oidak District.**

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that a public notice shall be issued to all members of the Tohono O'odham Nation to be effective immediately.**

**The foregoing Resolution was presented to the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 01<sup>ST</sup> Day of SEPTEMBER, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present, and by a vote of 804.0 FOR; 977.0 AGAINST; 146.0 NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, failed to pass because it did not receive a majority of the votes cast as required by Section 2 of Article V of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation.**
