

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Sanitation Facilities Deficiency System Priority Ranking)**

RESOLUTION NO. 98-364

WHEREAS, Indian Health Service, Division of Environmental Health and Engineering (OEH&E) conducts an assessment of Sanitation Facilities Deficiencies, annually; and

WHEREAS, the Division of Environmental Health and Engineering assessment does have an impact upon congressional appropriations and IHS allocation of funds; and

WHEREAS, Indian Health Services has provided for Tribal Priority ranking of the four (4) most critical projects and does allocate points impacting upon overall prioritization of projects; and

WHEREAS, the Division of Environmental Health and Engineering has provided recommendations to the Tohono O'odham Nation regarding the most critical needs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation has reviewed and approved the entire priority list and has determined that the following deficiencies are the four most critical and desirable, in descending order or prioritization:

- 1. Cold Fields Water (Phase 3)**
- 2. Gu Vo Water**
- 3. Anegam Water**
- 4. Cold Fields Water (Phase 1)**

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 15TH. day of SEPTEMBER, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,927.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and (04) ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (c)(2), (f) & (j) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


