

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Intergovernmental Agreement Regarding Statewide
Gang Task Force)**

4 **WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Public Safety (“DPS”) has organized a**
5 **Statewide Gang Task Force under a program entitled GITEM (Gang**
6 **Intelligence Team Enforcement Mission); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Statewide Gang Task Force is composed of 34 law enforcement officers**
8 **from 10 state, federal, county and municipal law enforcement agencies**
9 **who work together as a unit; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O’odham Police Department (“TOPD”) has negotiated an**
11 **Intergovernmental Agreement with DPS to allow for participation of one**
12 **TOPD officer on the Statewide Gang Task Force, which officer would be**
13 **paid as usual by TOPD but whose salary, overtime and benefits would be**
14 **reimbursed on a monthly basis by DPS to the Tohono O’odham Nation;**
15 **and**

16 **WHEREAS, the TOPD officer would work outside the jurisdiction of the Tohono**
17 **O’odham Nation and under the supervision of DPS but would acquire**
18 **training and knowledge regarding methods of law enforcement among**
19 **gangs, which training and knowledge will be transferred to other TOPD**
20 **officers for use within the jurisdiction of the Nation; and**

22 **WHEREAS, the reimbursement from DPS will be paid into the General Fund of the**
23 **Tohono O’odham Nation; and**

24 **WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Agreement does not require any outlay of funds of**
25 **the Nation aside from the police officer salary and benefits already**
26 **budgeted for by TOPD; and**

27 **WHEREAS, this Intergovernmental Agreement has been reviewed by the Domestic**

Legislative Council and is recommended for approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the Intergovernmental Agreement Regarding Statewide Gang Task Force substantially in the form attached hereto and authorizes the Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation to sign it on behalf of the Nation, and to sign any other documents and take any other actions reasonably necessary to implement this Intergovernmental Agreement.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 15TH day of SEPTEMBER, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,927.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and (05) ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




