

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approval of the Memorandum of Agreement between the Tohono O'odham  
Nation and the State of Arizona Department of Economic Security)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 98-372**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation will enter an agreement with the State of Arizona Department of Economic Security for the administration of the Native Employment Works (NEW) program under the Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunities Reconciliation Act (PRWORA); and**

**WHEREAS, the designated service delivery area for the Tohono O'odham Nation is the boundaries of the reservation; and**

**WHEREAS, the designated service delivery area for tribal members living off the boundaries of the Tohono O'odham Nation are designated Arizona Department of Economic Security administration; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation JTPA/NEW Program will coordinate referral and verification procedures with the local ADES Family Assistance Administration Office in accordance with ADES Policy and Procedures.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby approves the Memorandum of Agreement between the Tohono O'odham Nation and the State of Arizona Department of Economic Security.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Memorandum of Agreement, herein, shall not be construed as an expressed or implied waiver of the Tohono O'odham Nation's sovereign immunity.**

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract, provided however, that any amendment affecting the funding or funding**

levels of this contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 15TH day of SEPTEMBER, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,927.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and (06) ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




