1 2 3 **RESOLUTION NO. <u>98-374</u>** 4 WHEREAS, the Initiative (IN-01-97) known as the "O'odham Voice" was passed into 5 law on June 28, 1997, and provides for "a charitable organization within 6 the Nation"; and 7 WHEREAS, IN-01-97 appropriates and authorizes a "set aside from gaming revenues" 8 in the amount of \$1,000,000 for use by such an organization for the 9 purpose of "handling and distribution of funds to needy O'odham"; and 10 WHEREAS, IN-01-97 requires the creation of an 11 member Board (hereinafter "the 11 Board"), consisting of "1 member from each District" to "establish an 12 O'odham Charitable Organization on the reservation"; and 13 WHEREAS, IN-97-01 requires that all overhead costs shall be paid from additional 14 gaming revenues; and 15 WHEREAS, under Executive Order 97-002, an eleven member interim board was 16 established by the Chairman of the Nation, consisting of the eleven 17 district chairs, which did meet and identify both a budget for operational 18 costs amounting to \$220,138.75 and Eligibility Criteria and Procedures 19 for Distribution of Funds by the O'odham Charitable Office (hereinafter 20 "OCO"), as attached and incorporated by this reference; and 21 WHEREAS, in order to qualify for tax deductions for monies received by OCO, 22 expenditure of such monies by a donor qualifies as a charitable deduction 23 for the donor under the Indian Tribal Governmental Tax Status Act (26 24 U.S.C. 7871); and 25 WHEREAS, receipt of charitable funds or services by an applicant is excludable from 26 gross income under Internal Revenue Code (26 U.S.C. 61) and is 27 excludable under the general welfare doctrine therein; and 28

Board membership requirements. Candidates recommended by the Districts for the initial Board shall be reviewed by the Vice Chairman of the Nation together with the Rules Committee of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, and qualified candidates selected thereby shall be appointed by the Chairman of the Nation and confirmed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council. This initial Board and subsequent Boards shall have independent authority to replace Board members through a process which ensures maximum community participation.

- C. Term of Office. No less than six Advisory Board members shall be selected for a two year term, and no less than five Advisory Board members shall be selected for a three year term. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council shall determine which members shall serve two year terms and which members shall serve three year terms.
- D. Vacancies. An Advisory Board member may voluntarily resign his/her position at any time through written communication to the Chairperson or Secretary of the Board, or may be removed by a majority vote of the Board. Vacancies shall be filled for the remainder of the departing Board member's term with an individual from that respective departing Board Member's District according to the procedures established in Section 2.B above.
- E. Advisory Board Officers.
 - (i) Number. The principal officers of the Advisory Board shall consist of a Chairperson, a Vice-Chairperson, and a

Secretary.

- (ii) General Duties. Officers of the Advisory Board shall have the following specific duties and such other duties as may be determined by Board action.
- (iii) The Chairperson of the Advisory Board. The Chairperson of the Advisory Board shall preside at all meetings of the Board, and shall perform all duties associated with the office of Chairperson and such other duties as from time to time may be assigned to him/her by the Advisory Board.
- (iv) The Vice-Chairperson. The Vice-Chairperson shall act in the capacity of the Chairperson in the absence of the Chairperson. The Vice-Chairperson shall be responsible for any additional duties as designated by the Chairperson of the Advisory Board.
- the written minutes of each meeting of the Advisory Board.

 S/he shall ensure that all notices are duly given. S/he shall be the official custodian of all records and, in general, shall perform all duties incident to the office of the Secretary, and such other duties as from time to time may be assigned to him/her by the Advisory Board, or the Chairperson. The Secretary may delegate the recording of minutes to a Recording Secretary who may be designated from the personnel of the O'odham Charitable Office.
- F. Removal. The Advisory Board may for good cause shown and by a majority vote, remove any member of the Board.

Remuneration. No member of the Advisory Board shall receive 3 remuneration for services rendered in the capacity of an Advisory 4 Board member. 5 3. The OCO shall meet with the Advisory Board on a monthly basis for 6 purposes of review of the program; and 7 The OCO shall be under the oversight of the Domestic Affairs 8 Committee, and the Budget and Finance Committee, of the Tohono 9 O'odham Legislative Council; and 10 The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves the budget 11 \$220,138.75 for overhead costs as identified by the Advisory Board as 12 attached hereto and incorporated by this reference; and 13 The OCO shall be established effective October 1, 1998 (FY99) and the 14 Chairman of the Nation is hereby authorized to initiate the hiring 15 16 process prior to the beginning of the fiscal year.
