6		Legislative Council) enacted Ordinance 05-82 entitled "The Alcohol
7		Beverage Licensing and Control Ordinance," for the purposes of
8		"alternatively prohibiting or sanctioning and licensing the introduction,
9		sale, possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages within the
10		exterior boundaries of the Papago Reservation in Arizona"; and
11	WHEREAS,	Section 4 (Four) titled, "District Option", of Ordinance 05-82 empowers the
12		eleven districts of the Tohono O'odham Nation to "sanction the
13		introduction, sale, possession and consumption of spirituous liquor
14		within the exterior boundaries of the district" so long as it conforms with
15		the purposes of Ordinance 05-82; and
16	WHEREAS,	the Sif Oidak District by a referendum vote of its eligible voting members,
17		made it lawful and legal to sell, possess and consume alcoholic beverages
18		within the boundary of its district; and
19	WHEREAS,	on August 4, 1998, the Tohono O'odham Nation Saint Francis Feast
20		Committee requested from the Tohono O'odham Nation's Police
21		Department, security and service beginning September 20, 1998 - October
22		5, 1998, in order to curb Bootlegging, transporting, illegal drugs,
23		dangerous weapons, home security/property, curfew violations
24		enforcement, domestic violence, and to conduct a roadblock on October
25		4, 1998; and
26	WHEREAS,	on August 24, 1998, the Sif Oidak District Council did approve a motion to
