1  $\mathbf{2}$ 3 **RESOLUTION NO. <u>98-377</u>** 4 WHEREAS, Natural Resources Consulting Engineers ("NRCE") was recommended by 5 experts in the field of Indian water law as uniquely and exceptionally 6 qualified to perform the technical studies necessary to prepare Indian 7 water claims for settlement and litigation; and 8 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation entered into a contract with NRCE pursuant 9 to a tribal budget approved by the Legislative Council for fiscal year 1991 10 (the "NRCE Contract"); and 11 WHEREAS, the purpose of the NRCE Contract was to prepare a study which quantified **12** the water rights and assessed damages to such rights in the Sif Oidak and 13 surrounding Districts (the "Sif Oidak Claim"); and 14 WHEREAS, in fiscal year 1991 the Nation was awarded federal funding pursuant to a 15 P.L. 93-638 Contract, No. CTH54T61016 (the "638 Contract"), to continue 16 the assessment of the Sif Oidak Claims, a project now designated as the 17 18 Gila River Adjudication Program (the "Program"); and 19 WHEREAS, all 93-638 funding to the Nation through the Bureau of Indian Affairs 20 ("BIA"), including funding under the 638 Contract, is now administered 21 under a Contract with the BIA, bearing an effective date of October 1, 1996 22and designated Contract No. 1450CTH54T61071 (the "BIA Master 23 Contract"); and 24 by Modification Nos. 15 and 26, the sum of \$164,288.78 was identified as WHEREAS, **25** unexpended and unobligated under the 638 Contract, and was 26 transferred to the BIA Master Contract for expenditure in the Program;

RESOLUTION NO. 98-377 (Approving Budget for Subcontract with Natural Resources Consulting Engineers under Gila River Adjudication Program for Period Ending September 30, 1999) 1 Page 2 of 4 WHEREAS, by Modification No. 5 to the Master BIA Contract, the sum of \$100,000 was 3 added to the Contract and made available for expenditure in the 4 Program: and 5 WHEREAS, the foregoing Modifications have transferred a combined total of 6 7 \$264,288.78 (the "Available Funds") to the Master BIA Contract for 8 expenditure in the Program; and 9 WHEREAS, the technical work on the Program has been exclusively performed by 10 NRCE pursuant to a subcontract with the Nation, as modified by 11 Amendment Nos. 1 through 5 thereto (the "NRCE Subcontract"); and 12 WHEREAS. uninterrupted continuation of the Program requires that the Legislative 13 Council approve a budget for expenditure of the Available Funds through 14 September 30, 1999 and that the Subcontract be amended to extend its 15 term to September 30, 1999 and continue NRCE's engagement; and 16 WHEREAS, the Water Resources and Budget & Finance Committees recommend 17 approval of this Resolution by the Legislative Council. 18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT: 19 1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves 20 Amendment No. 6 to the NRCE Subcontract which (a) extends the 21 term of the Subcontract to September 30, 1999 and (b) authorizes 22 the expenditure of \$264,288.78 for all work performed under the 23 Subcontract from October 1, 1996 through September 30, 1999, 24 pursuant to the budget attached thereto as Exhibit B. 25 The Chairman of the Nation is authorized and directed to execute 2. 26
