

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Internal Modification No. 005 for Grant Agreement 6-FG-32-00100)**

RESOLUTION NO. 98-379

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did previously adopt calendar year budgets containing funding projections for administration of the P.L. 93-638 Grant Agreement No. 6-FG-32-00100; and

WHEREAS, the previously adopted budgets for calendar year 1998 did change slightly during negotiations with Bureau of Reclamation; however, the original total request is not affected by this modification; and

WHEREAS, the Water Projects Office has presented this modification to the appropriate committees and the committees wish to bring it before the Legislative Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby approves Budget Modification No. 005 to the Grant Agreement, and authorizes expenditures as identified in the modification attached.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 16TH day of SEPTEMBER, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,785.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 142.0 NOT VOTING; and (03) ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
