needs; and**

**WHEREAS, a budget modification has been submitted which does not change the
funding level, but includes new line items and modifies other line item
amounts to address current needs.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that
it hereby approves the amendment to the Project 2000 and authorize
expenditures in accordance with the attached budget modification.**


**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 17TH. day

O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and
approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on
March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


