4 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved the FY 98 Judicial**
5 **Branch budget in Resolution No. 97-391. Thereby, authorizing the**
6 **appropriated funds for expenditure by the Judiciary; and**

7 **WHEREAS, due to circumstances beyond the Judiciary's control, a period of**
8 **approximately eight months in FY 98 lapsed during which time the**
9 **Executive review process, which includes approval of bid documents**
10 **greatly delayed the Judiciary's time schedule for completion of this**
11 **project; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the extensive review process prevented the Children's Program project,**
13 **that includes the renovation and construction of the existing boy's and**
14 **girl's home, along with the school facility project, from being completed**
15 **in FY98. Consequently, these projects are not expected to be completed**
16 **until February 1999; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the Judiciary Branch is committed to the completion of these projects,**
18 **which require additional authorization for expenditures in FY 99,**
19 **requests that these projects be re-authorized; and**

20 **WHEREAS, the funds for FY 98 identified for these projects in the amount of**
21 **\$550,614.00 have not been re-obligated and remain restricted and**
22 **available for the purpose in which they were funded and intended for.**

24 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that**
25 **the attached budget, *Tohono O'odham Judiciary Branch Request for Re-***
26 ***Authorization of FY 98 Appropriation Funds*, is hereby approved as**
27 **submitted and is authorized to be expended accordingly.**
