

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Adoption of the Scholarship Fund Fiscal Year 1999 Budget and
Appropriating Funds From the Nation's Gaming Revenues)**

RESOLUTION NO. 98-401

WHEREAS, the Executive Branch has prepared and approved the Scholarship Fund budget for fiscal year 1999; and

WHEREAS, the Scholarship Fund FY 99 budget has been submitted to the legislative oversight committees for review and approval; and

WHEREAS, the legislative committees have reviewed the proposed base budget and recommend approval; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended that the funds required by the budget will be from the Nation's gaming revenues received during fiscal year 1999.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Scholarship Fund Fiscal Year 1999 Budget is hereby approved and is authorized to be expended accordingly.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the funds required for the budget will be from the Nation's Gaming Revenues received during fiscal year 1999.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 18TH day of SEPTEMBER, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,737.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 190.0 (06) ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
