## RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (FY 1999 Tribal Base Budget - Law Enforcement Tohono O'odham Police Department)

1 2 **RESOLUTION NO. 98-403** 3 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation with a land base of 2.8 million acres and a 4 population of 23,000 members contracts its own Law Enforcement. 5 6 Detention and Ranger program under P.L. 93-638; and WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council acknowledges that the 7 8 638 budget is not enough to effect adequate law enforcement; and 9 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council responds to the increased 10 demand for law enforcement by supporting the Police Department's 11 request for Tribal Dollars in addition to the 638 budget in the amount of 12 \$5,937,570.88. 13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council of 14 the Tohono O'odham Nation authorizes an "off the top" appropriation of 15 Tribal gaming revenues in the amount of \$5,937,570.88 for Law 16 **Enforcement Detention and Ranger Services.** 17 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Treasurer of the Tohono O'odham Nation is 18 hereby authorized to withdraw and transfer such funds as may be 19 necessary for the expenditures of the Department as provided in the 20attached budget. 21The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 18TH, day of SEPTEMBER, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1.737.022 FOR: -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 190.0 (06) ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono 23 O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 24 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). 25 TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL **26** 27 Dennis Ramon, Legislative Chairman
