RESOLUTION NO. 98-404

WHEREAS, the Executive Branch has prepared and approved the Executive Branch Initiative Administration Budgets for fiscal year 1999;

Youth Recreation Centers	\$356,257.45
Economic Development Department	\$ 1,108,481.88
Economic Development Grants	\$ 3,500,000.00
Initiative Legal Research	\$ 50,000.00
Enrollment Payroll	\$ 63,074.84; and

WHEREAS, the budget as approved identifies critical operational costs that must be funded prior to the beginning of fiscal year 1999 in order to avoid any adverse impacts upon the operations of the programs listed; and

WHEREAS, time does not permit a thorough joint review by the Executive Branch and the Budget & Finance Committee of these budgets for appropriation; and

WHEREAS, the legislative Budget and Finance Committee and the Executive Branch recommend that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council grant authorization for the Executive Branch to continue operations of the identified program for a period not to exceed 90 days beginning October 1, 1998 pending appropriations of the budgets requested.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Executive Branch is hereby authorized to continue operations of the Youth Recreation Centers, Economic Development Department, Economic Development Grants, Initiative Legal Research and Enrollment Payment Roll for a period of 90 days beginning October 1, 1998 pending appropriations of the budgets requested.
