## RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Approval of Well Maintenance Program FY'98 Budget Modification #2)

1 **RESOLUTION NO. 98-409**  $\mathbf{2}$ WHEREAS, the Well Maintenance Program provides service and maintenance of 3 stock and private wells and water storage tanks not maintained by the 4 Tohono O'odham Utility Authority water system; and 5 WHEREAS, upon review of expenditure report for the Program it has been discovered 6 that there is a shortage of funds allocated for the Supplies-other and the 7 Office & Communication Equipment line items; and 8 WHEREAS, in fiscal year 1998, the Well Maintenance Program has incurred costs in 9 line item 752 Office & Communication Equipment, although this line item 10 was not included in the budget; and 11 12 WHEREAS, the Well Maintenance Program would like to correct this oversight by creating an Office & Communication Equipment line item and by utilizing 13 14 savings from the Salaries line item to satisfy the overages. 15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council 16 approves budget modification #2 for the Well Maintenance Program by 17 creating an Office & Communication Equipment line item. 18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that \$3,500 be transferred from the Salaries line item for 19 distribution to cover the shortages in the Office & Communication 20 Equipment and Supplies-other line items. 21 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 18TH. day of SEPTEMBER, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1.737.022 FOR; <u>-0-</u> AGAINST; <u>-0-</u> NOT VOTING; and <u>190.0 [06]</u> ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham 23 Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, 24 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). **25** TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL 26 27 Dennis Ramon, Legislative Chairman 28
