5 **the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorization to continue the FY**
6 **98 Budget pending completion of needs assessment; and**

7 **WHEREAS, said assessment and review is to be completed prior to October 1,**
8 **thereafter, the FY 1999 budget request will be forwarded to the**
9 **appropriate Legislative Committee for review and to forward their**
10 **recommendation to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council**
12 **hereby approves the San Lucy District request to continue District**
13 **Operation under the FY-1998 Budget.**

14 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 23RD day**
15 **of SEPTEMBER, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,927.0**
16 **FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the**
17 **Council by Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham**
18 **Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by**
19 **the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,**
20 **pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
