2 **RESOLUTION NO. 98-417** 3 WHEREAS, at a Special Legislative Council Session on September 23, 1998 the 4 Pisinemo District did present the District FY-99 Budget: and 5 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did review the proposal of the 6 Pisinemo District; and 7 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative did determine that there was sufficient 8 funds in the Nation's Distribution of \$557,871.57 and the Pisinemo 9 District Money Market Account 235267027 to support this proposal; and 10 WHEREAS, the Pisinemo District Council did approve their FY-99 Budget through 11 Pisinemo District Council Resolution 98-11, dated September 15, 1998. 12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council 13 does approve the FY-99 Operating Budget of the Pisinemo District in the 14 amount of \$669.449.00. 15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the amount of \$292,981.57 (\$557,871.57 (Gaming 16 Distribution) less \$264,890.00 (amount applied to 99 District Budget) has 17 been identified for investments by the Pisinemo District Council. 18 19 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the <u>23RD.</u> day of <u>SEPTEMBER, 1998</u> at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of <u>1,927.0</u> 20 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham 21 Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). **2**3 TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL 24 25 Dennis Ramon, Legislative Chairman 26 24 th day of September, 19 98 27
