1 2 **RESOLUTION NO. 98-421** 3 WHEREAS. the Tohono O'odham Nation recognizes the need to obtain legislative and 4 administrative advocacy services in regard to programs and services of the 5 Federal government of the United States of America; and 6 WHEREAS, the firm of Ducheneaux, Taylor & Associates has continued to provide 7 adequate services in Fiscal Year 1998 including; to advise the Nation 8 9 regarding Federal initiatives; to act as liaison with the Federal Executive 10 and Legislative Branches; to arrange meetings with Federal Officials; to 11 provide specific reports on services provided directly to the Nation; and 12 WHEREAS, funds in the amount of \$60,000.00 plus \$10,000.00 have been appropriated 13 in anticipated expenses by the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham 14 Nation for the purpose of obtaining these services in Fiscal Year 1999. 15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative 16 Council that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials to wit; the Chairman 17 or any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute 18 the contract provided in the amount of \$60,000.00 plus \$10,000.00 in 19 anticipated expenses, and that any amendments affecting the funding **2**0 levels of the contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this 21 Council 22 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the contract period will be from October 01, 1998 23 through September 30, 1999. 24 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 23RD. day 25 of SEPTEMBER, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1.832.5FOR; <u>94.5</u> AGAINST; <u>-0-</u> NOT VOTING; and <u>[01]</u> ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in 26 the Council by Section 1(d)(2) and Section 2(a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986: 27 and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on

March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
