1 2 RESOLUTION NO. 98-431 3 WHEREAS. on June 28, 1997 the voters of the Tohono O'odham Nation (the "Nation") 4 approved Initiative No. IN-01-97 (the "Initiative"); and 5 WHEREAS. the Initiative authorized funding from Gaming Revenues for several 6 7 measures, including a one-time per capita distribution of \$2,000 to each 8 member of the Nation enrolled on June 28, 1997 (the "Initial Per Capita 9 Distribution"); and 10 WHEREAS. pursuant to Resolution 97-451, the Legislative Council adopted an 11 Initiative Funding and Implementation Plan (the "FIP") which authorized 12 the establishment of set-aside accounts for the Initial Per Capita 13 Distribution and other Initiative measures, and set certain conditions on 14 the expenditure of funds from such accounts; and 15 WHEREAS. by Resolution 97-478, the Legislative Council approved the transfer of 16 funds from the Desert Diamond Savings Account to certain designated set-17 aside accounts established at Bank of America Arizona, including the sum 18 of \$41.5 million to set-aside account no. 3030425-1067524 for the Initial 19 Per Capita Distribution (the "Per Capita Account"); and 20 WHEREAS, three of the conditions to expenditure of the Per Capita Account specified 21 in the FIP are (1) approval by the Secretary of the Interior of a per capita 22 distribution plan (the "Revenue Allocation Plan") pursuant to the 23 requirements of the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act, 25 U.S.C. § 2710 (b) (3); 24 (2) acceptance by the Legislative Council of a Certification of Eligible 25 Members submitted by the Enrollment Office and based upon receipt of 26 27 a properly completed and filed Certificate of Eligibility Verification for Per 28 Capita Payment for each member; and (3) as to each Minor Eligible

RESOLUTION NO. 98-431 (Accepting Certification of Eligible Members and Authorizing the Expenditure of Funds for Per Capita Payments under the Initiative) 1 Page 2 of 4 2 Member, establishment of a restricted account at Bank of America for 3 deposit of such member's per capita payment; and 4 WHEREAS. pursuant to Resolution 97-452, the Legislative Council adopted a Revenue 5 Allocation Plan and caused the Plan to be submitted for approval by the 6 Phoenix Area Office of the Bureau of Indian Affairs in accordance with 7 authority delegated to the Area Office by the Secretary of the Interior; and 8 9 WHEREAS. by letter dated December 18, 1997, the Area Office approved the Revenue 10 Allocation Plan with respect to the Initial Per Capita Distribution and 11 disapproved the Plan with respect to the Biennial Per Capita Payments: 12 and 13 WHEREAS. an agreement with Bank of America has not yet been finalized for the 14 establishment of the restricted accounts which is required as a condition 15 to disbursement of the Initial Per Capita Distribution to such accounts for 16 Minor Eligible Members; and 17 WHEREAS. pursuant to Resolution Nos. 97-525, 98-010, 98-037, 98-084, 98-192, 98-207, 18 98-278, 98-316, and 98-360 the Legislative Council accepted and approved 19 Certifications of Eligible Members for the Initial Per Capita Distribution, 20 and disbursements have been made to such Members: and 21 WHEREAS, the Enrollment Office has filed with the Legislative Council a Certification 22 of Eligible Members listing 57 adult members who are eligible for receipt 23 of the Initial Per Capita Distribution; and 24 WHEREAS, all conditions under the laws of the United States and the Nation have 25 been satisfied to permit the disbursement of the Initial Per Capita **26** Distribution to the members listed in the Certification of Eligible 27 28 members.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 12TH, day of OCTOBER, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,666.0 FOR; 71.0 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 190.0 [07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(d)(1), (2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
