RESOLUTION NO. 98-436

WHEREAS, the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'Odham Nation is empowered to secure the health, welfare and education of the membership of the Nation and considers educational advancement of tribal members as among the highest of priorities; and

WHEREAS, the Council is authorized through the provisions of P.L. 93-638 to enter into agreements and partnerships with external agencies and educational institutions in order to secure and foster greater benefits, opportunities and educational access for the tribal membership; and

WHEREAS, the high secondary school attrition rate and low postsecondary enrollment rates of tribal members are matters of the greatest concern and must be addressed if the Tohono O'Odham Nation is to meet its goals of self-determination and economic independence; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation intends to actively participate in the proposed partnership with Pima Community College, the University of Arizona and other Tribal entities for the purpose of applying for and conducting an Upward Bound Program that will serve Tohono O'Odham high school students and other American Indian participants.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council herein endorses the joint application submitted through the East Campus of Pima County Community College to the Upward Bound Program (CFDA 84.047A) as provided by U.S.C. 1221e-(a) (1), and directs the Nation's Chairman to sign this resolution of support and intent to participate.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, or his designee, is directed to sign a proposal pre-agreement and to subsequently

March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


