1 **Equally Distributed to the Eleven Districts**) 2 3 RESOLUTION NO. 98-445 4 pursuant to Tohono O'odham Council Resolution No. 94-098, "Authorizing 5 Gaming Revenue Distribution Formula", an allocation of gaming revenue 6 funds was provided to each of the 11 Districts: and 7 WHEREAS, the District Chairmen were approached by Hickiwan District with a 8 request to utilizing the Nation's Gaming Revenue Savings as a source for 9 supplemental funding to provide additional services to their 10 constituencies; and 11 12 WHEREAS, all the Districts realize that the August 1998, gaming revenue allocation 13 is insufficient to meet their respective constituents needs during FY99: 14 and 15 WHEREAS, all the Districts have the need to utilize some of the Nation's Gaming 16 Revenue Savings: and 17 WHEREAS, the Districts believe that an allocation of \$5.5 million to them would assist 18 in meeting more needs of their constituents; and 19 WHEREAS, a majority of the district councils enacted resolutions supporting this 20 request. 21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council 22 hereby supports a supplemental distribution of \$5.5 million from the 23 24 25

savings portion of the Tohono O'odham Nation's Gaming Revenues to all eleven districts, to enable them to meet the needs of their constituencies.
