

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Supporting the Request for a Supplemental Distribution of \$5.5 Million  
from the Tohono O'odham Nation Gaming Revenue Savings to be  
Equally Distributed to the Eleven Districts)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 98-445**

**WHEREAS, pursuant to Tohono O'odham Council Resolution No. 94-098, "Authorizing Gaming Revenue Distribution Formula", an allocation of gaming revenue funds was provided to each of the 11 Districts; and**

**WHEREAS, the District Chairmen were approached by Hickiwan District with a request to utilizing the Nation's Gaming Revenue Savings as a source for supplemental funding to provide additional services to their constituencies; and**

**WHEREAS, all the Districts realize that the August 1998, gaming revenue allocation is insufficient to meet their respective constituents needs during FY99; and**

**WHEREAS, all the Districts have the need to utilize some of the Nation's Gaming Revenue Savings; and**

**WHEREAS, the Districts believe that an allocation of \$5.5 million to them would assist in meeting more needs of their constituents; and**

**WHEREAS, a majority of the district councils enacted resolutions supporting this request.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby supports a supplemental distribution of \$5.5 million from the savings portion of the Tohono O'odham Nation's Gaming Revenues to all eleven districts, to enable them to meet the needs of their constituencies.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the \$5.5 million will be distributed equally to the eleven districts of the Nation in the amount of \$500,000 per district.**



The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 15TH day of OCTOBER, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 917.0 FOR; 700.0 AGAINST; 310.0 NOT VOTING; and [07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


