

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Resolution of the Continuance of Authority for the Executive Branch to
Manage all Activities of the Nation's Farming Operations for an Additional
60 Days or until December 31, 1998)**

RESOLUTION NO. 98-449

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved Resolution No. 98-129 which authorized the Executive Branch to assume all management functions of the Nation's farming operations for an additional 180 days or until September 30, 1998 ; and

WHEREAS, the majority of farming management and operational functions have been addressed and completed; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the overwhelming number of issues and concerns, the instrument which guides the Nation's farming efforts, namely the Plan of Operation, has not been completed to the satisfaction of the Executive Branch; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council and tribal members should receive any and all benefits of a review prior to any discussion(s), and ultimately, making a democratic decision for final approval of the Plan of Operation; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Branch and the Executive Agriculture Committee requires additional time to complete the final draft for review, seek nominations for appointment to the Tohono O'odham Farming Authority board and provide a timely and successful transition to the newly elected board officials.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Chairman of the Nation be authorized to continue all management functions associated with the Nation's farming operations and to complete the final steps towards completion of detailed responsibilities, retroactive to September 30, 1998, for a continuance until December 31, 1998.
