1 RESOLUTION NO. <u>98-465</u> 2 WHEREAS, by Resolution 97-433 the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved an 3 Attorney Contract with the law firm of Williams & Janov, now known as 4 Williams, Janov & Cooney (the "Attorneys"), to provide legal representation 5 with respect to certain of the Nation's water matters; and 6 WHEREAS, the Attorney Contract expired on September 30, 1998; and 7 WHEREAS, continued representation regarding water matters is required to protect 8 the Nation's interests: and 9 WHEREAS, the Attorney General has recommended an extension of the Attorney 10 Contract for fiscal year 1999 in the amount of \$10,000; and 11 WHEREAS, the operating budget of the Office of Attorney General for fiscal year 1999 12 includes sufficient funding for the Contract; and 13 WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee recommends approval by the Legislative 14 Council of an Attorney Contract with the Attorneys on such terms. 15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT: 16 The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves an Attorney 17 Contract with the law firm of Williams, Janov & Cooney in the amount 18 of \$10,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1999 and in the form 19 attached hereto. 20 2. Funding for the Attorney Contract shall be provided under the 21 operating budget of the Office of Attorney General for fiscal year 1999. 22 The Chairman of the Nation is authorized and directed to execute the 23 **Attorney Contract.** 24 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the <u>03RD</u>. day 25 of NOVEMBER, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1.785.026 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 142.0 NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 2 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham 27 Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,

pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
