

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Attorney Contract with the Law Firm of Raven & Kirschner)**

RESOLUTION NO. 98-468

WHEREAS, an Initiative, No. IN-01-97 (the "Initiative"), was approved by the voters of the Tohono O'odham Nation on June 28, 1997; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Legislative Council Resolutions 97-435 and 98-265, the Nation entered into an Attorney Contract, and Amendment No. 1 thereto, with the law firm of Raven & Kirschner (the "Attorneys") to assist the Office of Attorney General in assessing the tax implications for the Nation and its members associated with the implementation of the Initiative; and

WHEREAS, the Attorney Contract expired on September 30, 1998; and

WHEREAS, continued representation is necessary to protect the Nation's interests in these matters; and

WHEREAS, an Initiative Legal Research budget (the "Budget") in the amount of \$50,000 (Account No. 01-1809-810) was approved for fiscal year 1998 for legal costs associated with implementation of the Initiative; and

WHEREAS, pending approval of the Budget for fiscal year 1999, by Resolution 98-404 the Legislative Council authorized continuing expenditures at the rate approved in the fiscal year 1998 Budget for a period of 90 days commencing October 1, 1998; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Resolution 98-404, the Attorney General has recommended an extension of the Attorney Contract for fiscal quarter ending December 31, 1998 in the amount of \$12,500; and

WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee recommends approval by the Legislative Council of an Attorney Contract with the Attorneys on such terms.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves an Attorney**

Contract with the law firm of Raven & Kirschner, in the form attached hereto, in the amount of \$12,500 and for a term ending on December 31, 1998.

2. Funding for the Attorney Contract shall be provided under the Initiative Legal Research budget pursuant to the continuing resolution.

3. The Chairman of the Nation is authorized and directed to execute the Attorney Contract.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 03RD. day of NOVEMBER, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,106.5 FOR; 820.5 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 2 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




