1 2 RESOLUTION NO. 98-472 3 WHEREAS, pursuant to Legislative Council Resolutions 97-432, 98-140 and 98-336, the 4 Nation entered into an Attorney Contract, as modified by Amendments Nos. 5 6 1 and 2, with the law firm of Fines & Oden (the "Attorneys") for the purpose of providing legal representation to the Nation in connection with the 7 operational and financial affairs of the Tohono O'odham Farming 8 Authority ("TOFA"); and 9 WHEREAS, the Attorney Contract expired on September 30, 1998; and 10 WHEREAS, a civil lawsuit has been filed in federal court against Wayne Evans and 11 other asserting claims related to TOFA's operational and financial affairs, 12 13 captioned Tohono O'odham Nation v. Evans et al., No. CIV-97-555-TUC-WDB (U.S.D.C., Ariz.) (the "Federal Lawsuit"); and 14 WHEREAS, continued representation in the Federal Lawsuit and other matters related 15 16 to TOFA is necessary to protect the Nation's legal interests; and WHEREAS, the Attorney General has recommended an extension of the Attorney 17 Contract for fiscal year 1999 in the amount of \$60,000; and 18 WHEREAS, the operating budget for the Office of Attorney General for fiscal year 1999 19 20 has sufficient funds for a Contract in such amount; and WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee recommends approval by the Legislative 21 Council of an Attorney Contract with the Attorneys on such terms. 22 23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT: The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves an Attorney 24 Contract with the law firm of Fines & Oden in the amount of \$60,000 for 25 the fiscal year ending September 30, 1999 and in the form attached **2**6 hereto. 27
