

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Adopting the TOUA Subsidy Implementation Plan)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 98-473**

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3 **WHEREAS, on June 28, 1997, the voters of the Tohono O'odham Nation approved**  
4 **Initiative No. IN-01-97 (the "Initiative") which, inter alia, sets aside \$1**  
5 **million to establish a welfare fund to provide qualified elderly and low-**  
6 **income members of the Nation with assistance payments covering the**  
7 **cost of utility services provided by the Tohono O'odham Utility Authority**  
8 **(the "TOUA"); and**

9 **WHEREAS, in order to implement the Initiative, the Tohono O'odham Legislative**  
10 **Council (the "Legislative Council") did October 14, 1997, by Resolution No.**  
11 **97-451, adopt the Initiative Funding and Implementation Plan which,**  
12 **inter alia, (1) establishes the Initiative--Utility Subsidy Account; (2) sets**  
13 **aside \$1 million in the account with Bank of America; (3) sets out the**  
14 **mechanism for future funding, conditioned upon Available Gaming**  
15 **Revenues; and (4) sets out criteria for the expenditure of funds set aside**  
16 **in the Initiative--Utility Subsidy Account; and**

17 **WHEREAS, in order to establish proper criteria for the expenditure of the funds set**  
18 **aside in the Initiative--Utility Account, TOUA has submitted the attached**  
19 **TOUA Subsidy Implementation Plan for review and approval by the**  
20 **Legislative Council, as well as a request for administrative costs to cover**  
21 **the initial costs of putting the Plan in place.**

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

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24       **1. The Legislative Council hereby approves the TOUA Subsidy**  
25       **Implementation Plan in the form attached hereto.**  
26       **2. The Legislative Council does hereby appropriate the sum of**  
27       **\$20,000.00 from the (Initiative--Administrative Costs Account**  
28       **established pursuant to the Initiative Funding and Implementation**

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Plan) (interest accrued to date in the Initiative--Utility Subsidy Account established pursuant to the Initiative Funding and Implementation Plan) (any other source) to TOUA to cover the initial costs of putting the Plan in place.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 03RD. day of NOVEMBER, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,718.0 FOR; 114.0 AGAINST; 95.0 NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 2 (d) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
