RESOLUTION NO. 98-474

**WHEREAS, the Initiative (IN-01-97) known as the "O'odham Voice" was passed into
law by a vote of the membership of the Nation on June 28, 1997; and**

**WHEREAS, the Planning and Economic Development Department has been
designated the responsibility of implementing the Initiative - Youth
Recreation Center goals; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council did approve
establishment of a set-aside budget for the overall thirty million dollars
(\$30,000,000) to accomplish this goal; and**

**WHEREAS, the Planning and Economic Development Department has conducted a
needs assessment and resource inventory within the Districts; and**

**WHEREAS, the Planning and Economic Development Department has identified
expenses to be incurred during FY-99 in the development and
construction of Youth Recreation Centers in compliance with the
proposed timeline; and**

**WHEREAS, the Commerce and Budget & Finance Committees have reviewed the
attached one year project implementation and construction and
associated timeline.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council of the Tohono
O'odham Nation approves the Youth Recreation Project budget as
proposed by the Planning and Economic Development Department in the
amount of ten million dollars (\$10,000,000.00) for FY-1999.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation
authorizes the Executive Branch to implement the Youth Recreation**




