

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Appointing Joseph Joaquin to the Elderly Advisory Committee of the  
National Congress of American Indians NAGPRA Committee)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 98-481**

**WHEREAS, the Native American Graves Protection and Repatriation Act (NAGPRA) Committee has been established by the National Congress of American Indians (NCAI); and**

**WHEREAS, at the 55<sup>th</sup> Annual Session of NCAI in October 1998, the NAGPRA committee appointed Joseph Joaquin to serve on the newly formed Elderly Advisory Committee subject to the approval of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, Joseph Joaquin is currently the Cultural Affairs Specialist in the Office of Cultural Affairs, Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, Joseph Joaquin has agreed to the appointment; and**

**WHEREAS, the Cultural Preservation Committee of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby agrees with and supports the appointment of Joseph Joaquin to the Elderly Advisory Committee.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby approve the appointment of Joseph Joaquin to the Elderly Advisory Committee, of the NAGPRA Committee, under the National Congress of American Indians for a term to be established by the NAGPRA Committee, and requests the Chairman of the Legislative Council to transmit a letter and a copy of this resolution to the NAGPRA Committee of NCAI.**

**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 05TH. day of NOVEMBER, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,785.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 142.0 [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (b) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


