

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Authorizing the Tribal Employment Rights Office ("TERO") and Safe Ride  
Services, Inc. to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 98-484**

**WHEREAS, Safe Ride Services, Inc., a private company, provides non-emergency  
medically necessary transportation services on the Tohono O'odham  
Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, by Resolutions No. 91-377, 98-004, 98-142 & 98-280 the Nation has permitted  
Safe Ride Services, Inc. to provide non-emergency medically necessary  
transportation services within the Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, Resolution No. 98-280 requires that TERO and Safe Ride Services, Inc. to  
develop and submit a Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") for the  
Legislative Council's approval; and**

**WHEREAS, TERO and Safe Ride Services, Inc. have developed a MOU which is attached  
as Exhibit "A" and is incorporated herein by this reference; and**

**WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee of Legislative Council has  
reviewed and approved the attached MOU; and**

**WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee recommends that the  
Legislative Council approve the MOU.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

- 1. The Legislative Council approves of the MOU; and**
- 2. The TERO and Safe Ride Services, Inc. are authorized and directed to  
execute the MOU.**

**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 05TH. day  
of NOVEMBER, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,635.0  
FOR; -0- AGAINST; 150.0 NOT VOTING; and 142.0 [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers  
vested in the Council by Section 2 (d) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono  
O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and  
approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on  
March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
