

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving a Supplemental Set-A-Side Appropriation of \$5.5 Million from  
the Tohono O'odham Nation Gaming Revenue Savings to be Distributed  
Equally among the Eleven Districts of the Nation)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 98-486**

**WHEREAS, pursuant to the Tohono O'odham Council Resolution No. 94-098,  
"Authorizing Gaming Revenue Distribution Formula", an allocation of  
gaming revenue funds was provided to each of the Eleven (11) Districts of  
the Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, the District Chairpersons were approached by Hickiwan District with a  
request to utilize the Nation's Gaming Revenue Savings as a source of  
supplemental funding in order to provide additional services to their  
constituents; and**

**WHEREAS, all the districts of the Nation realize that the Gaming Revenue Allocation  
made in August 1998, is insufficient to meet their respective constituents  
needs for fiscal year 1999; and**

**WHEREAS, all the districts of the Nation have a need to utilize some of the Nation's  
Gaming Revenue Savings; and**

**WHEREAS, the districts believe that a Set-A-Side Appropriation from the Gaming  
Revenue Savings of \$5.5 million to be distributed equally among the eleven  
districts of the Nation, would assist in meeting more needs of their  
constituents; and**

**WHEREAS, a majority of the councils of the eleven districts of the Nation have enacted  
resolutions supporting this appropriation.**

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby  
supports and approves a supplemental set-a-side appropriation of \$5.5  
million from the savings portion of the Tohono O'odham Nation Gaming  
Revenues to all eleven (11) districts of the Nation to address district  
priorities.**



**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the \$5.5 million will be divided equally to the eleven (11) districts of the Nation in the amount of \$500,000 per district. The Funds will be disbursed upon presentation and adoption of district budgets to the Legislative Council.**

**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 05TH, day of NOVEMBER, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,173.0 FOR; 612.0 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 142.0 [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**




