

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Membership and Appointing Frances G. Antone as the Nation's
Representative to the Southwest Indian Agriculture Association (SWIAA))**

RESOLUTION NO. 98-503

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation currently has within its boundaries farming
interests consisting of the Papago, Vaiva Vo and the San Lucy Farms; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation currently also has under construction a farm
at the Garcia Strip Community within the Schuk Toak District, Tohono
O'odham Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has an invested interest in the field of
agriculture for its members; and**

**WHEREAS membership in the Southwest Indian Agriculture Association (SWIAA) is
open to any Indian organization recognized by its Tribal Government
and/or federally recognized Tribe with an interest in the management and
development of Indian Agriculture resources; and**

**WHEREAS the Agriculture Committee of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has
oversight responsibility for the Tohono O'odham Nation's agricultural
interests; and**

**WHEREAS the Agriculture Committee recommends that the Tohono O'odham Nation
be a member of and have a representative to the Southwest Indian
Agriculture Association (SWIAA) to voice the Nation's interests and position
on Indian agricultural issues; and**

**WHEREAS, the Agriculture Committee has discussed and recommends to the Tohono
O'odham Legislative Council the appointment of Frances G. Antone as the
Tohono O'odham Nation's representative to the Southwest Indian
Agriculture Association (SWIAA); and**

**WHEREAS, membership dues for the Tohono O'odham Nation in the amount of two
hundred dollars (\$200.00) for calendar year 1999 are due and payable.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
hereby approves the Nation's membership in the Southwest Indian**

Agriculture Association (SWIAA) and authorizes payment of annual membership dues in the amount of two hundred dollars (\$200.00) for calendar year 1999.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council appoints Frances G. Antone as the Tohono O'odham Nation's representative to the Southwest Indian Agriculture Association (SWIAA).

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Southwest Indian Agriculture Association (SWIAA) membership dues for the Tohono O'odham Nation be appropriated from the Legislative Branch Budget.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 07TH day of DECEMBER, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,927.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [0] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (b) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


