

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Request to make Vamori Bridge Project and Vamori Community Road  
a Priority for Tohono O'odham Nation)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 98-506**

**WHEREAS, Chukut Kuk District has enacted three resolutions, 95-36, 96-36 and 98-03  
which all express the need for a bridge over the Vamori was; and**

**WHEREAS, the Vamori community road became a priority as a result of a survey  
conducted in 1994 by the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and**

**WHEREAS, the community road is a school bus route and meets the eligibility criteria  
for being on the Bureau of Indian Affairs Roads Maintenance Schedule; and**

**WHEREAS funding has been identified for the bridge and community road through  
the efforts of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council by Resolution No. 97-  
073 as part of the Congressional Appropriations; and**

**WHEREAS the Bureau of Indian Affairs Branch of Roads Division, Phoenix Area Office  
was in receipt of the Nation's request for the Vamori Bridge from the  
Congressional Representative; and**

**WHEREAS Chukut Kuk District and Vamori Community request that the Vamori  
Bridge and the Vamori Community Road be made a priority for the Tohono  
O'odham Nation.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council  
hereby declares the Vamori Bridge Project and the Community Road a  
priority for the Tohono O'odham Nation.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby request  
that the Bureau of Indian Affairs include the Vamori Community road as  
part of the Vamori Bridge Project and be placed on Bureau of Indian Affairs  
Roads Maintenance Schedule for maintenance and improvement.**

**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 08TH day of  
DECEMBER, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,927.0 FOR;  
-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the  
Council by Section 1 (j) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation,  
adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting  
Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to  
Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**




