1 2 3 **RESOLUTION NO. 98-511** 4 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation (Nation) engaged Miller, Allen & Co., P.C., 5 Certified Public Accountants (Auditors) to conduct the Nation's 1996 audit 6 as required by the Single Audit Act; and 7 WHEREAS, the Auditors have completed the audit of the Nation's 1996 financial 8 statements: and WHEREAS, the Auditors sampled and questioned and sampled over \$6,503,214.31 of 9 questioned costs; and 10 WHEREAS, the Nation's Accounting Department has resolved all but \$38,440 of these 11 questioned costs which is subject to reimbursement to the funding 12 agencies. 13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council 14 accepts the 1996 Audit report as presented. 15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Nation appropriates \$38,440 to reimburse the 1996 16 questioned costs as identified by the audit. 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the source of funding for the above appropriation shall 18 be from the Nation's budgeted amount for Audits made available in fiscal 19 vear 1999. 20 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the <u>08TH</u>, day of 21 DECEMBER, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,927.0 FOR; <u>-0-</u> AGAINST; <u>-0-</u> NOT VOTING; and [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the 22 Council by Section 1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting 23 Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). 24 TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL 25 26 27 28
