- 1. As a continued sign of good faith and the Nation's sincere desire to resolve the disputes in litigation through negotiation, authorization for payment of the gaming device assessment fee at the rate of \$500.00 per gaming device per annum, is hereby extended pending resolution of the issue either through negotiation or litigation.
- 2. In accordance with Resolution No. 95-383, the Executive Director of the Gaming Office and the Commerce Committee are authorized to meet with representatives of the State to negotiate the gaming device fee and shall present to the Legislative Council for approval the final proposal for a new fee rate.
- 3. Nothing contained herein shall be interpreted or construed as affecting or limiting the authorization for payment of actual costs incurred by ADOG presented in timely notices from ADOG in accordance with Section 12(b), sentence 7, of the Compact, as provided in Resolution No. 96-233.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the <u>09TH.</u> day of <u>DECEMBER</u>, <u>1998</u> at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of <u>1.870.0</u> FOR; <u>57.0</u> AGAINST; <u>-0- NOT VOTING</u>; and <u>[03]</u> ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section <u>1 (f)</u> of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
