

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 1999 Addition of Line Item to Tribal Base Budget and Transfer of Funds -
Law Enforcement Tohono O'odham Police Department)**

RESOLUTION NO. 98-521

WHEREAS, for fiscal year 1999 the Tohono O'odham Police Department was appropriated funds to address various needs of the community and the Police Department's programs; and

WHEREAS, due to the increase in the number of Police Officers and Rangers to the Tohono O'odham Police Department, there is a need for specialized equipment and trained animals in order to enhance patrol of range lands of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and

WHEREAS, there is no line item in the current FY 1999, Tohono O'odham Police Department budget for trained animals such as horses to be used for search and rescue operations, crowd control, cattle rustling deterrence, public relation operations, detection of illegal drugs; and

WHEREAS, in order to purchase such equipment and animals a new line item must be established as the Trained Animal Account - 01 1090 753 and a transfer of \$17,000.00 from the 01 1090 750 to 01 1090 753 is necessary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby approves the establishment of a new line item account number 01 1090 753 Trained Animals to the FY 1999 Tohono O'odham Police Department Tribal Base Budget.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that \$17,000.00 from 01 1090 750 Capital Account line item be transferred to 01 1090 753 Trained Animals Account line item to be expended accordingly.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 09TH day of DECEMBER, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,415.0 FOR; 512.0 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


